This CD includes the choral sections of the work at both the normal tempo and a slower <code>StudySpot</code> tempo. You can use the <code>StudySpot</code> sections to learn notes in the fast and/or difficult passages and then check yourself on the next tract which is the same passage but back at normal tempo – the performance speed.

The table below indicates the track number where each individual chorus in the work begins, the chorus title, the page numbers and the location on the page where needed.
